




JUBILEE PRAYER



1. Fold along the green dotted line half way down this page so that this side of the paper is on the inside.



2. Fold in half again, so you have a little booklet. The Passport Cover page (with space to write your name and parish) should be on the front, and the Jubilee Prayer on the back.

YOUR PILGRIM PASSPORT

At each of the major Pilgrimage Sites visit the Parish Office to get your Pilgrim Passport stamped:

- Diocese of Broken Bay Cathedral
 Our Lady of the Rosary, Waitara
- Shrine of Hope for Families
 St Patrick's, Gosford
- Shrine of Hope for Young People
 Our Lady of Dolours, Chatswood
- 4 Shrine of Hope for Priests & Vocations Mary Immaculate, Manly

When you have visited all 4 sites and had your passport stamped at each, show your stamped passport at your parish office and they will register your completion so that you can receive a certificate.

There will be processions and walking routes suggested through the course of the Holy Year at each of our Shrines of Hope. You can record these as a souvenir of the paths you walked during the Jubilee!
